Unit Overview

Canaipa Ward is Redland Hospital's designated cardiac ward. It is a 17-bed unit that offers comprehensive healthcare services to patients. It caters to a broad spectrum of patients, focusing mainly on Cardiology and Stroke Services. The primary services provided by the unit include telemetry, acute stroke care, and acute medical assessment.

- Orientation to clinical unit/working alongside preceptor (4 days)
- Graduate Nurse Study Day (4 days)
