Redland Hospital Permanent Pool Graduate Registered Nurse Program is a part time position at 0.5 FTE, covering staffing needs throughout Redland Hospital in Medical, Surgical, ED, PACU, and other areas, with a focus on self-directed learning.

- Education includes 4 Study Days and 1 Acute Care Workshop.
- Support Available Mon-Fri AM from Graduate Clinical Facilitators
